Allegro will have stages at both the Paddock and the Turf Club facilities, in order to utilize the naturally inviting and historic setting to create a family-friendly experience that will provide attendees with memories they will never forget.

Kids under 17Yrs of age enter free with adults so this spurs classical musicians and artists of the future.
